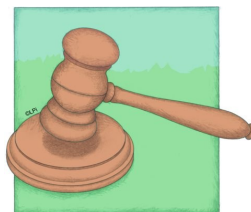

## Grants Awarded

The Boosters award grants throughout the school year. Our most recent grants went to:

- Friends of Maury Library received \$399.86 for box sets of books and a Play Station game system.
- The High Five Club received \$754.66 to purchase equipment to start a school café.
- The Media Center received \$220.94 for book binding and frames for archival materials.
